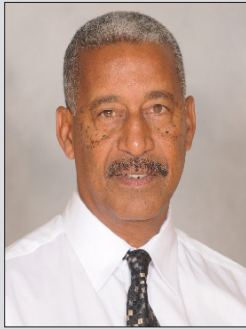

Today's Match-Up

Coppin State takes on the University of West Virginia for the second consecutive season. The Mountaineers lead 6-0 in the all-time series with Coppin State following last season's 88-56 victory. In that game, Coppin State trailed, 32-29, at halftime. Five of the six games in the series have been played in Morgantown.

Coppin State Season Preview

The Eagles return seven players from last season's team that won 17 games and advanced to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) championship game last year. The returnees include senior forward Bria Harris and juniors Janelle Lane, Jordan Swails, Tanaysa Henderson and Omaah Tayong and Amber Griffin along with sophomore Keena Samuels. Coppin State was picked fourth in the MEAC in the preseason coaches poll.

Last Time Out For Coppin State

Coppin State fell to No. 19 Georgia, 49-29, in a non-conference contest at Stegeman Coliseum Tuesday night. Jordan Swails led the team with six points and four rebounds. Keena Samuels added five points and three rebounds. Amber Griffin notched four points and four assists. Janelle Lane and Bria Harris tallied four points and five rebounds apiece. The Eagles held the Lady Bulldogs below 50 points, the fewest allowed by Coppin State this year. The 49 points were also a season-low point total for Georgia, which was picked sixth in the SEC preseason coaches' poll. For the game, Coppin State held Georgia to 26 percent shooting from the field.

About West Virginia

Members of the Big XII Conference, the Mountaineers are 5-1 following an 80-52 victory over Fairleigh-Dickinson Wednesday night. Junior guard Bria Holmes posted 25 points, collected four steals and handed out three assists in the win. She made 11-of-20 from the field with three triples. Senior Linda Stepney added 13 points and dished out two assists in the win. Meanwhile, Avere Fields added 10 points, pulled in nine rebounds and had four steals. The Mountaineers are currently ranked 24th in the Associated Press poll and 21st in the Coaches' Poll. Holmes is ninth in the nation in scoring averaging 24.8 points per game for the Mountaineers, who are 4-0 at home this season. Meanwhile, Fields is averaging 16 points and 6.7 rebounds per contest. West Virginia was picked to finish third in the Big XII preseason coaches' poll.

Coppin State has posted three consecutive winning seasons. Under head coach Derek Brown, the Eagles have had winning seasons 10 times in his 15 years. Coppin State has had five 20-win seasons under Brown.

Tough Sledding

Coppin State's December schedule reads like the Top 25 poll. The Eagles have faced or will face three teams currently ranked in this week's Associated Press Top 25 poll: Maryland (No. 15), Georgia (No. 19) and West Virginia (No. 24). In addition the Eagles' remaining December opponents: Mt. St. Mary's, VCU and Miami all participated in postseason play last season.

Career Efforts This Season

Bria Harris and Janelle Lane scored their career-best point performances against Virginia Union with 21 and 20 points, respectively. Lane also tied her career-high with 10 rebounds. Keena Samuels earned a career-high 17 points against Wake Forest. Jordan Swails and Amber Griffin tied their career-high 16 point performances against N.C. State. Swails also set a new personal single-game rebounding standard with eight boards. Tanaysa Henderson tallied a career-best nine points.

Setting the Nets on Fire

Janelle Lane picked up where she left off last season with her shooting. She made 50 percent of her shots last season and she opened the year with a 7-for-10 effort against N.C. State. Lane leads the Eagles in scoring, averaging 13.8 points per game. Meanwhile, Swails made all six of her shot attempts against the Wolfpack. The duo also combined to shoot 12-for-19 against Robert Morris. Keena Samuels is shooting 16-for-18 from the free throw line.

Strong Defense

In their last two games against Virginia Union and Georgia, the Eagles have permitted an average of 52.5 points. For the season, Coppin State has held three teams below 40 percent shooting, including its last two opponents. The Eagles held Georgia to a season-low point total (49) and shooting percentage (26.3).

A Family Affair

Junior guard Jordan Swails and assistant head coach Billie Wilson are a dynamic mother-daughter duo for the Eagles.

Fresh Faces

Coppin State welcomes freshmen Oluwaseun Adeniji, Candice Beverly, D'Ajahnae Smith and sophomore Genesis Lucas to the team in 2014-15.

The shirt and card were mailed to the MSJ athletic departments.

"It felt good doing the challenge for Lauren," Lucas said. "She's inspired me to take what I do more seriously and become more dedicated because not everybody gets the chance to do everything that they want to do. We are definitely praying for her and she'll be in our thoughts throughout this season."

Mixing It Up

Coppin State will face schools from eight different conferences this season (ACC, Big 12, CIAA, Northeast, Atlantic 10, Big 10, America East, and SEC).

Southern Hospitality

The Eagles will spend the majority of their away games playing down south, including against North Carolina State (Nov. 16), Wake Forest (Nov. 23), Georgia (Dec. 2), Miami (Dec. 13), North Carolina Central (Jan. 24), and North Carolina A&T (Jan. 26).

Familiar Faces

Coppin State will play non-conference contests against Robert Morris, Virginia Union, UMBC, West Virginia, and Miami for the second straight season.

Renewing A Rivalry

Coppin State hosts Maryland on Sunday, Dec. 21. This will be the first time Maryland plays in the Eagles' Physical Education Complex. The two teams have not met since the first round 2008 NCAA Tournament. The Terrapins participated in last season's Final Four where they lost to conference foe Notre Dame.

Lone senior Bria Harris leads Coppin State in rebounding at 9.4 per game. She had a career-high 21 points against Virginia Union. She posted her first career double-double (18 points, 10 rebounds) against UMBC. Harris also grabbed a career best 12 rebounds against Robert Morris. Harris has grabbed four or more rebounds 19 times since the start of last season.

In Her Lane

Janelle Lane leads the Eagles in scoring (12.2 ppg) and field goal percentage (50.5 percent). She has scored in double figures four times this season. She scored a career-high 20 points and had 10 rebounds against Virginia Union for her second career double-double. Lane had 18 points against Robert Morris. She grabbed six or more rebounds nine times last season.

No Fly Zone

Sophomore Omaah Tayong leads the Eagles with seven blocked shots. She had a season-high 12 points and nine rebounds against Wake Forest. She grabbed a season-best 10 rebounds against Virginia Union.

Pass the Ball

Junior Amber Griffin leads the Eagles with 15 assists. She tied her career-high with 12 points against NC State in the Eagles' opener. She has 216 career assists. Griffin had a season-high four assists against Georgia.

Super Swails

Junior Jordan Swails made all six of her shots against NC State to finish with a career-high tying 16 points. She also made 5-of-10 shots to finish with 11 points against Robert Morris. Her 5.6 rebounds per game is second on the team.

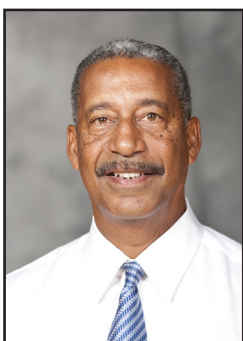
