West Virginia in 2015-16: 25-10, 12-6 Big 12  
Coppin State in 2015-16: 16-16, 10-6 MEAC**SATURDAY'S MATCHUP**

Coppin State (0-3) completes their four game road trip to start the season with a matchup against the #21/25 ranked West Virginia Mountaineers (2-0) on Saturday, Nov. 19 at 1 p.m. This will be the eighth meeting between the schools with West Virginia winning the previous seven meetings including a 96-64 win last season on Nov. 16, 2015.

**LAST GAME AT GEORGE WASHINGTON**

Senior guards Keena Samuels and Vanessa Neal both scored in double figures against George Washington in a 77-46 loss on Wednesday. The Eagles scored a season-high 46 points, made 17 field goals and a pair of three-pointers. Samuels dropped a season-high 17 points with six rebounds and four assists. Neal had a career-high 12 points, five rebounds in 35 minutes played. Freshman Chance Graham scored six points, grabbed six rebounds and recorded a pair of blocked shots. GW made 45% (32-70) of their attempts from the field while CSU struggled on 25% (17-66). The Eagles made ten free-throws compared to only six by GW but the Colonials held the advantage on the boards 58-33.

**GRAHAM NAMED MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

Freshman Chance Graham was named the MEAC Rookie of the Week, announced on Monday, Nov. 14th. The award marks Coppin State's first Rookie of the Week award this season. Graham averaged a double-double of 10.0 points and 10.0 rebounds against VCU and Virginia. She registered 13 points, nine rebounds, two steals, one block and one assist against Virginia.

**ABOUT THE MOUNTAINEERS**

#21/25 ranked West Virginia (2-0) won both of their games to begin the season and will host the Eagles for their third consecutive home contest. Five are averaging in double figure scoring led by Tynice Martin and Lanay Montgomery is averaging 12.0 ppg with 15.5 rpg.

**ON DECK FOR COPPIN STATE**

Coppin State will host Stephen F. Austin in their 2016-17 home opener on Friday, Nov. 25 at 3 p.m.

**2016-17 EAGLE RETURNERS**

Coppin State returns six letterwinners who competed last season, including two of the team's starters – senior guard Keena Samuels and red-shirt junior guard Genesis Lucas. Other prominent contributors back from last season's team are graduate guard Vanessa Neal, junior forward Candice Beverly, junior center Oluwaseun Adeniji and sophomore Alexis Taylor. In all, Coppin State's roster includes three seniors, three juniors, one sophomore and four freshmen.

**EAGLES LOOK TO REBOUND AFTER LOSS IN 2016 MEAC TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME**

The 2016-17 Eagles will have vengeance on their minds after coming up short in the MEAC Women's Basketball Tournament championship game to North Carolina A&amp;T. A new head coach will lead the Eagles after the retirement of Derek Brown who served on the Coppin State sidelines for 17 seasons. Coppin State alum, DeWayne Burroughs takes over and will have big shoes to fill this season. The 2015-16 team led the MEAC in field goals percentage (39.7) and in both steals (32.1) and steals per game (10.0). Guards Genesis Lucas and Keena Samuel started on

last season's squad that advanced to the MEAC tournament championship game.

### YEAR ONE

DeWayne Burroughs became the seventh head coach in the 31 year history of the women's basketball program. Burroughs is a Coppin State alum and last season was at the District of Columbia where he served as the head women's basketball coach in 2015-16 and previously as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator since 2011.

### LUCAS TOPS 2015-16 MEAC ASSIST LIST

Guard Genesis Lucas finished the 2015-16 season as the conference leader in assists. Lucas averaged 4.3 assists per game and finished with 130 total ranking 86th in the nation. In 13 games she recorded five or more assists including a career-best ten assists versus North Carolina Central (2/18/16).

### SENIOR EXPERIENCE

Guard Keena Samuels, forward Vanessa Neal and forward Tiara Goode are the only seniors on the 2016-17 roster. Samuels is the only returning Eagle that averaged double figure scoring (11.7) last year. She started in 30 games and was the Eagles top-scorer and ranked 12th in the MEAC in points per game. Samuels finished with 19 double figure scoring games including 14 out of 17 conference games. Neal is in her second year at Coppin State after transferring from Niagara University. Goode is a transfer from the University of the District of Columbia where she previously played for Coach Burroughs.

### WELCOME TO THE EAGLE NEST

Burroughs adds four freshman and a graduate student he previously coached while at UDC to the Eagles six returners. Goode averaged 10.1 points with 5.6 rebounds per game last season on Burroughs' UDC team that went 21-9 and made it to the conference semifinals in 2015-16. Freshmen Mia Crooms and Jordan Meaurie Pickett are guards that will learn from Lucas and Samuel throughout the year. Crooms was named an honorable mention to the 2015 All-Bronx Girls Basketball Team. The rookie post players feature Chance Graham and Oluwadamilola Oloyede. Graham was ranked 37th in the DMV list for Next Sports Phenom and was also named Ms. Maryland Basketball by the Maryland Basketball Coaches Association. Oloyede received the Washington Post All-Met honorable mention in 2016.

### PRESEASON PROJECTIONS

Coppin State was selected seventh in the preseason MEAC poll, announced on Oct. 27th by the women's basketball coaches and sports information directors. North Carolina A&T was picked to finish first, collecting 13 of 26 first-place votes, while Bethune-Cookman was selected second (and secured five first-place votes). Coppin State was picked to finish seventh in the conference race. The Eagles last won the MEAC regular-season title in 2006-07 and last won the tournament in 2008.

- Scored in double figures nine times and led the team in scoring three times
- Finished first on the team and second in the MEAC in Assist to Turnover Ratio (1.2)

**Keena Samuels – 5-7 – senior, guard – Upper Marlboro, Md. (Largo HS)**

- Led the team in scoring with 373 points, averaging 11.7 points per game which ranked 12th in the MEAC
- Finished with 19 double figure scoring games including double figures in 14 of 17 MEAC games
- Finished with three games of 20 or more points
- Tied for second on the team with 58 steals, which was tied for sixth in the MEAC

## HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH DEWAYNE BURROUGHS

DeWayne Burroughs will begin his first season as the head women's basketball coach at Coppin State University in the 2016-17 season. Burroughs, a Coppin State alum, comes from the University of the District of Columbia where he served as the head women's basketball coach last season and previously as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at UDC since 2011.

Burroughs guided his 2015-16 UDC Firebirds to a 21-9 overall record. The squad earned their fourth 20-plus win season and made their fourth appearance in the ECC semifinals both in the last five years. They were ranked ninth in the NCAA Division II East Region poll entering the tournament.

During his four-year tenure as an assistant coach, Burroughs helped the Firebirds reach three NCAA Tournaments (2012, 2014 and 2015), win the program's first East Coast Conference Tournament Championship (2014) and its first ECC Regular Season Championship (2015), as well as set school single-season records for wins (25) and consecutive wins (14). In 2014-15, the Firebirds were ranked as high as No. 18 and finished No. 22 in the final USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll.

As recruiting coordinator, Burroughs brought in three All-ECC performers: Denikka Brent, Telisha Turner and Tajruba Baldwin-Kollore. Brent was an ECC All-Rookie Team selection in 2012, a two-time First Team All-ECC performer in 2013-14 and 2014-15, the 2014-15 ECC Defensive Player of the Year and a First Team Daktronics All-East Region selection. Turner was a First Team All-ECC performer in 2013-14 and a Second Team All-ECC selection in 2014-15. She was also the ECC Tournament Most Valuable Player in 2014. Baldwin-Kollore (Criminal Justice – Newport News, VA/Denbigh HS), who is one of nine returning student-athletes from last year's record-setting squad, was an All-ECC Honorable Mention selection last season.

Burroughs' previous college coaching stops were Chesapeake College and Bowie State University. While at Bowie State, Burroughs served as an assistant coach and the recruiting coordinator. He helped guide BSU to two 9th-place Atlantic Region rankings, two Eastern Division titles and two CIAA Finals appearances. Burroughs also recruited two CIAA defensive players of the year, three CIAA All-Rookie team selections and several players that went on to earn CIAA All-Conference honors.

Before advancing to the college level, Burroughs served as head coach at Woodlawn High School, St. Paul School for Girls, and Northwestern High School. He compiled a high school coaching record of 143-40. While at Woodlawn High School, Burroughs won four Baltimore County Championships and three Regional Championships, and earned one State Semi-final appearance and two State Final appearances.

Burroughs also served as an AAU coach for Maryland Freeplay from 1991-2006. He produced numerous student-athletes that went on to very successful playing careers and are now coaching on the high school and collegiate levels.

Burroughs played baseball at his alma mater Coppin State University where he received a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice and a minor in Sports Management. He was recently inducted into the Coppin State University Hall of Fame Class of 2015. Burroughs later went on to receive his Masters Degree from Mountain State University in Organizational and Strategic Leadership.

Burroughs is married to the former Tabby Rideout (Columbia, MD) and they are the parents of three children: Kristina, Christopher and Stephanie
