- Senior **Kyndal Skersick** posted her third career 20-point game in Saturday's win over N.C. Wesleyan. After going 8-of-11 from the field, Skersick vaulted into the top-10 in the Big South with a shooting percentage of .432 on the season.

LAST TIME OUT

- Freshman **Kemari Jones** broke out for her first career double-double, with 14 points and 11 rebounds, and senior **Kyndal Skersick** scored 20 points to lead Longwood to a convincing 100-57 win over N.C. Wesleyan Saturday afternoon inside Willet Hall.
- Four Lancers finished the game in double figures, as each player that played for the squad scored at least four points.
- The 100-point game for Longwood is the most points scored in the **Bill Reinson** era and marks the first contest the Lancers have tallied 100 points since posting a 101-83 victory over St. Andrew's during the 2002-03 season.

BY THE NUMBERS

- The Lancers will square off against three schools from Power-Five conferences — No. 9 Oregon State, Virginia and West Virginia. The three games against the power five is the third most of any team in the Big South.
- Longwood opened the 2015-16 season with six of its first seven games on the road. The first two games of the season came against NCAA Tournament squads in 2015 with Oregon St. and James Madison. In addition, Virginia -- the third opponent for the Lancers -- was among the field at the 2015 WNIT.
- Raven Williams** and **Daeisha Brown** are poised to break the 1,000 point mark this season. Williams sits 170 points shy of the 1,000 point mark, while Brown is 140 points away.
- Micaela Ellis** is among the top-12 in the league in assists (2.7 APG) this season.
- In her return to the court this season, red-shirt-junior **Daeisha Brown** has started all but one game on the season and has scored in double figures in each of her last three games against N.C. Central and UNCG. Brown scored a season-high 20 points in her last game against High Point.
- Raven Williams** is the Big South's lone returning player to rank among the top-10 in the league in points (14.3 PPG, 4th), assists (2.2 APG, 6th), steals (1.5 SPG, 6th), and minutes played (34.7 MPG, 3rd).
- Junior college transfer **Eboni Gilliam** has had an immediate impact for the Lancers. The Richmond, Va., product ranks among the top-20 in the league in rebounding.
- Senior **Kyndal Skersick** has improved her shooting each season she has played at Longwood. This season, Skersick ranks among the top-10 in the league in FG PCT

SCOUTING THE MOUNTAINEERS

- West Virginia enters Wednesday's contest with a 7-2 overall record, which includes the team's current win streak that improved to five games Sunday with a 66-60 win over Marshall.
- Bria Holmes leads the Mountaineers offense this season with 18.0 points per game. The senior guard ranks second in the Big 12 Conference in scoring.
- Laney Montgomery controls the paint on defense for the Mountaineers with a Big-12 leading 32 blocks on the year. The 6-5, junior center also ranks among the Big South's top three in rebounding, grabbing 9.6 boards per game.
- West Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the Big 12 preseason poll.

NO ORDINARY FRESHMAN

- Freshman **Kemari Jones** picked up Big South Freshman of the Week honors Monday after posting her first career double-double in Saturday's win over N.C. Wesleyan. The freshman forward came off the bench to score 14 points and grab 11 rebounds.
- A product of Melbourne, Fla., Jones ranks among the top-10 in the Big South this season in free-throw percentage. With her 8-of-13 performance in Saturday's game against N.C. Wesleyan, Jones ranks 10th in the league with a .630 (17-of-27) free-throw percentage on the season.
- Jones comes to Longwood after a successful career at Melbourne Central Catholic. The 6-0, forward became a member of the school's 1,000 point club during her junior campaign. She was nominated to the McDonald's All-American game in her senior season.

- Senior **Raven Williams** and red-shirt-junior **Daeisha Brown** are on track to eclipse the 1,000 point mark during the 2015-16 campaign. Williams sits 170 points shy, while Brown is 140 points shy.

WILLIAMS PICKS UP PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Raven Williams** picked up a pair of accolades during the 2015-16 preseason. The Big South coaches tabbed Williams to the Second-Team Preseason All-Big South at the conference's media day. In addition, Williams was named to the CollegeSportsMadness.com Second Team Preseason All-Big

South.

- Last season, Williams enjoyed a breakout campaign where she averaged 13.3 points per contest. She was named Honorable Mention All-Big South.

LANCERS HIT THE CENTURY MARK

- In its game against N.C. Wesleyan, Longwood hit the 100-point plateau for the first time in the Bill Reinson era. The 100 points marks the first contest the Lancers have tallied 100 points since posting a 101-83 victory over St. Andrew's during the 2002-03 season.
- Each player on the squad that saw game action scored at least four points in the game, while five Lancers finished with at least three assists. Longwood finished the game with a season-high 20 assists

SKERSICK IMPROVEMENT BY THE YEAR

- Longwood senior **Kyndal Skersick** has improved each season she has been at Longwood. After shooting .138 her freshman season and averaging 0.6 points per game, Skersick has improved her shot in each successive season. So far in 2015-16, Skersick has improved to shoot .400 from the field, while scoring in double figures in four straight games.

TOUGH STRETCH TO OPEN 2015-16 SEASON

- Longwood played six of its first seven games on the road this season. Longwood faced an Oregon State (Nov. 13) team that advanced to the second round of last season's NCAA Tournament and was ranked No. 7 to open the season. Longwood also squared off against NCAA qualifier James Madison (Nov. 15) in Harrisonburg, Va. In addition, road contests against Virginia (Nov. 22), UNCG (Nov. 28) and the Big South opener against High Point (Dec. 1) will end the grueling opening portion for the Lancers. Longwood played its home-opener against NC Central (Nov. 24).
- In addition, the Lancers will play eight games against opponents that qualified for either the NCAA Tournament or Women's National Invitational Tournament in 2015.

ELLIS PRIMED FOR BREAKOUT SEASON

- Last season, **Micaela Ellis** came on strong at the end of the season and averaged 7.3 points per contest over her final nine games of the regular season. She finished second on the squad averaging 1.2 assists per contest.
- Through six games this season, Ellis has posted 18 assists to average 3.0 per game in the young season. She recorded a career-best six assists in Longwood's home-opener against N.C. Central and has notched five or more assists in two games this season.
- With her average of 3.0 assists per game against just seven turnovers on the season, Ellis is among the top-eight in the league in assists and atop the charts in assist-to-turnover ratio.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- The Longwood women's basketball team has selected four captains for the 2015-16 season, including **Micaela Ellis**, **Deborah Headen**, **Brenna Robbins** and **Raven Williams**.
- Headen and Williams assumed the captaincy role for the second straight year for the squad, while Ellis and Robbins are both first-time captains.

SIXTH SEASON UNDER REINSON

- Longwood is in its sixth season under the guidance of head coach **Bill Reinson**. In 2013, Reinson led the Lancers to the Big South Championship game, falling to Liberty.
