QUICK HITTERS

- West Virginia (7-2) knocked off Marshall for the 11th consecutive year with a 66-60 victory on Sunday in the annual Chesapeake Energy Capital Classic.
- Lanay Montgomery registered her second double-double of the year with 13 points and 12 rebounds to garner MVP honors. Bria Holmes also had a double-double with 12 points and 10 assists. Tynice Martin added a game-high 15 points and grabbed eight rebounds.
- Holmes paces the Mountaineers with 18.0 points per game, which ranks second in the Big 12.
- Montgomery's 9.6 rebounds per game are third in the conference. Her 3.6 blocks per game are tops in the league and third nationally.
- WVU and Longwood (2-6) meet for the fourth time on Wednesday, with the Mountaineers winning the three previous meetings. In the last meeting, WVU prevailed 74-43 over Longwood on Dec. 12, 2009.

SCOUTING LONGWOOD

- Longwood (2-6) opened the season 0-3 after losses to Oregon State, James Madison and Virginia. The team picked up its first victory of the season with a 60-49 triumph over North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. LU then lost three more before winning over N.C. Wesleyan last week.
- Longwood's offense is boasting 55.9 points per contest, while giving up 75.5 points per game to opponents.
- The Lancers are shooting at a 33.0 percent clip (158-of-479) in eight contests.
- Kyndal Skersick leads the Lancers in scoring with 10.6 points per game, while Eboni Gilliam averages 5.9 rebounds per contest. Kemari Jones was named the Big South freshman of the week after scoring 14 points and grabbing 11 rebounds in last week's win over N.C. Wesleyan.

WVU CAPTURES CAPITAL CLASSIC

- WVU won the Chesapeake Energy Capital Classic for the 11th consecutive season with a 66-60 win over Marshall on Sunday.
- The Mountaineers trailed by seven early in the first half before taking a 33-30 halftime lead. Marshall fought back to within three in the fourth quarter, but a layup and a three-pointer helped West Virginia secure the victory.
- Lanay Montgomery garnered MVP honors after scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and blocking three shots.
- Tynice Martin netted a team-high 15 points and grabbed eight rebounds in the win. Bria Holmes also netted a double-double with 12 points and 10 assists. Arielle Roberson recorded a season-best 12 rebounds versus the Herd.

OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

- WVU has shot 42.4 percent or higher in seven of nine games this season.
- The Mountaineers have eclipsed the 50 percent shooting plateau twice this season (59.0 vs. Coppin State and 54.0 vs. Fairleigh Dickinson).
- The Mountaineers are 29th nationally with a 45.6 field goal percentage.

DISHING OUT THE ASSISTS

- West Virginia has distributed double-figure assists in eight games this season and has registered 20 or more assists in three contests (24 vs. Coppin State, 23 vs. Morehead State and 23 vs. FDU).
- The Mountaineers are 37th in the NCAA with a 1.20 assist/turnover ratio and 51st with 16.8 assists per game.
- Freshman Olivia Seggie's assist-to-turnover ratio of 4.43 is second in the Big 12 and third nationally.
- Bria Holmes has recorded a 2.53 assist-to-turnover ratio, which is third in the league and 32nd in the NCAA.

COLISEUM WIN STREAK AT 11

- West Virginia has an 11 game win streak at the WVU Coliseum dating back to last season.
- The Mountaineers picked up regular season wins over Iowa State and Texas before reeling off five consecutive victories in the WNIT.
- WVU has four wins (Delaware State, Coppin State, Morehead State and Fairleigh Dickinson) this season.
- The 11-game win streak at the Coliseum is tied for sixth all-time.
- The Mountaineers won 16 consecutive games at the Coliseum from 2013-14 to 2014-15.

A TOUGH SLATE AHEAD

- West Virginia has the ninth toughest upcoming schedule in the country.
- WVU's future opponents have won 77.0 percent of their games (87-26) this season.
- Oklahoma leads the country with 80.2 percent, while Tennessee is second at 79.4 percent. Other Big 12 teams in the top-10 include No. 3 Kansas (79.0 percent), No. 5 TCU (77.8 percent) and No. 10 Baylor (76.6 percent).
- WVU holds a 66 RPI after nine games.
- Future non-conference opponent RPIs are: Elon (78), Indiana (79), James Madison (120) and Longwood (332).

CAREY'S HOMECOURT EDGE

- WVU is 379-163 (.699) all-time at the Coliseum.
- WVU is 173-44 (.797) all-time under Mike Carey, including a perfect 17-0 in 2010.
- WVU has won 22 straight games at the Coliseum against non-conference opponents dating back to 2014.
- WVU is 94-7 (.931) at home against non-conference teams since 2002.
- All 20 of West Virginia's top-20 crowds have been under coach Mike Carey.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Red Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Blue Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the sports communications staff.

HOLMES ADDED TO NAISMITH LIST

- Senior guard Bria Holmes was named to Naismith Trophy Watch List.
- Holmes joins four others from the Big 12 on the list: Imani Boyette (Texas), Nina Davis (Baylor), Niya Johnson (Baylor) and Britney Martin (Oklahoma State).
- Earlier this season, Holmes was tabbed to the John R. Wooden Award Top 30 list for a second consecutive year.

CAREY NOW ALL-TIME WINS LEADER

- With a win over Morehead State, coach Mike Carey surpassed Kittie Blakemore as WVU's all-time wins leader with 304 victories in 15 seasons.
- With a 68-50 win over Grand Canyon (Nov. 24), coach Mike Carey recorded his 300th career win at West Virginia.
- Carey has produced 304 victories in 15 seasons and holds a .651 winning percentage during that time.
- Additionally, Carey is just eight wins shy of reaching his 600th career victory.

- West Virginia completed the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame Challenge with a 2-2 record.
- The Mountaineers fell to Gonzaga (62-57) and USC (78-67 OT), while picking up wins over Grand Canyon (68-50) and Yale (70-60).
- WVU led the Spokane field with a 39.8 field goal percentage.
- Bria Holmes paced the Spokane field with 20.0 points, while Lanay Montgomery shot a field-best 69.2 percent from the field.
- Holmes netted a season-high 27 points in the overtime loss to USC on Nov. 23.
- Holmes was tabbed the MVP of the WVU-Yale game after boasting 18 points. Holmes averaged 19.5 points in the four-game tournament.

HISTORIC SEASON-OPENING WIN

- West Virginia women's basketball opened its 43rd season on Nov. 14 with a 77-34 win over Delaware State.
- The contest was the largest margin of victory for a season-opener in program history, surpassing the previous record of 40 points set when WVU opened with a 99-59 victory over West Virginia Wesleyan on Nov. 19, 1981.
- The Mountaineers own a 28-15 all-time record in season openers and have won eight out of their last nine.
- Coach Mike Carey has a 12-3 record in season openers.

Recap

Freshman Alexis Brewer tallied a game-high 14 points, as the West Virginia University women's basketball team cruised to a 77-34 victory over Delaware State in front of 2,232 fans in the season opener at the WVU Coliseum.

West Virginia (1-0) came out firing and led 18-4 after the first quarter. The Mountaineers held the Lady Hornets (0-1) to 11 or less points in the next three periods en route to the program's 19th consecutive win against non-conference opponents at the Coliseum. WVU is now 12-3 in season openers and 14-1 in home openers under coach Mike Carey.

Brewer, a native of Bardstown, Kentucky, connected on 6-of-7 field goals, snagged four rebounds, collected two assists and had a steal in 15 minutes of action. Teana Muldrow netted six fourth quarter points and finished the evening with 13 points and eight rebounds. Freshman Katrina Pardee rounded out WVU's double-figure scorers with 10 points, three rebounds and three assists.

Overall, WVU made 33-of-67 field goal attempts for 49.3 percent shooting. The Mountaineers connected on five three pointers and dished out 19 assists in the triumph. Delaware State (0-1) was outrebounded, 52-29, and committed 18 turnovers resulting in 23 West Virginia points.

Additionally, Lanay Montgomery almost notched a double-double with 10 rebounds and nine points. Montgomery also deflected four blocks in the contest. Preseason All-Big 12 honoree Bria Holmes posted nine points in the win, while another freshman Tynece Martin connected on seven points in her debut. Bri Justice and N'Kayah Kersey each had eight points to lead the Lady Hornets.

Jessica Morton and Holmes combined for eight of West Virginia's first 12 points to start the contest. The Lady Hornets finally got on the board with a bucket from Justice at the 4:06 mark in the opening period. West Virginia held DSU to just 13.3 percent (2-of-15) shooting in the opening quarter.

WVU outscored Delaware State by six, 17-11, in the second quarter. Three-pointers from Pardee and Brewer extended the Mountaineers lead to 22 with a minute remaining. Pardee finished the first half with a team-best eight points, while Amber Bogard led DSU with seven. The Mountaineers finished the first half shooting 45.5 percent (15-of-33), while holding Delaware State to 17.2 percent shooting (5-of-29).

An 18-3 run to open the second half pushed West Virginia's edge to 35. The Hornets used a short 8-3 spurt of their own to close the gap, but Brewer connected on a three-pointer to give WVU a 60-26 lead at the end of the period.

Recap

The West Virginia University women's basketball team cruised past Coppin State with a 96-64 victory Monday evening inside the WVU Coliseum.

The Mountaineers (2-0) fired on all cylinders offensively, scoring a Coliseum-record 63 points in half. That mark bested the previous record of 62 set against Duquesne in 1991. Coppin State (0-2) bounced back to score 38 points in the second half, as the Mountaineers eclipsed 90 points in the first time since tallying 101 against Saint Francis (Pa.) last season.

Senior guard Bria Holmes led all scorers with 23 points, while grabbing seven rebounds and dishing out five assists. The New Haven, Connecticut, native netted a new career-high 88.9 field goal percentage in 25 minutes of action. Holmes also climbed to No. 14 on the WVU's all-time scoring chart with 1,444 points, surpassing Maria Tchobanova (1,426) and Alexis Basil (1,429).

WVU saw another strong performance from Teana Muldrow off the bench, as the sophomore posted 17 points and grabbed eight rebounds in the win. Muldrow's 85.7 field goal percentage (6-of-7) also set a career-high. Freshman Tynece Martin reached double figures for the first time, scoring 14 points. Additionally, Jessica Morton led the Mountaineers with a career-high six assists, while scoring eight points.

Recap

The West Virginia University women's basketball team overcame a sluggish first quarter to knock off Morehead State, 94-56, on Wednesday evening, at the WVU Coliseum. The win gave coach Mike Carey his 302nd victory at WVU, as he surpassed legendary coach Kittie Blakemore as WVU women's basketball's all-time wins leader.

West Virginia (5-2) trailed the Eagles (3-5) 26-18 at the end of one quarter. Despite MSU taking a 10-point lead early in the second quarter, WVU outscored Morehead State 24-12 to take a four-point halftime advantage. In the third quarter, the Mountaineers outscored MSU 34-8 and never looked back as Carey collected his 302nd win.

Carey has recorded a .649 winning percentage in 15 years at the helm of the program. Blakemore, who couldn't be in attendance on Wednesday evening, sent her warmest regards.

Senior guard Bria Holmes netted a season-high 29 points, pulled in seven rebounds and dished out five assists in 29 minutes of action. Holmes made 12-of-18 from the field and connected on 4-of-5 from the charity stripe. The New Haven, Connecticut, native climbed to No. 9 on WVU's all-time scoring chart with 1,551 points, surpassing Olivia Bradley's 1,534 points.

Center Lanay Montgomery netted her fourth career double-double and first of the season with a season-best 12 points and 18 rebounds. She also netted a season-best six blocks. Her 18 boards were the eighth-most in a game by a Mountaineer junior.

Freshman Katrina Pardee added 12 points to round out WVU's double-figure scorers. Alexis Brewer, Teana Muldrov and Arielle Roberson each added eight points in the triumph. Freshman Olivia Seggie dished out nine assists with no turnovers, scored four points and grabbed three rebounds in the win. Seggie's nine assists were tied for ninth-most by a freshman in a game.

The Mountaineers finished the game shooting 42.7 percent (35-of-82), while holding Morehead State to 32.4 percent (23-of-71) from the field. The Mountaineers banked eight three-pointers and made 16-of-23 (69.6 percent) free throw attempts. WVU's 62 rebounds were a season-high, while WVU netted 32 second-chance points.

An explosive 23-4 West Virginia run in the third quarter catapulted the Mountaineer offense. At one point, Holmes scored nine consecutive points for WVU. West Virginia took a commanding lead that they would never relinquish, marking the 21st consecutive win over a non-conference opponent at the Coliseum.

Recap

The West Virginia University women's basketball team used a stifling defense to knock off Fairleigh Dickinson, 91-42, on Sunday at the WVU Coliseum.

The Mountaineers (6-2) opened the first quarter with a 27-7 edge and never looked back, as WVU notched its fourth consecutive victory. West Virginia recorded a season-high 16 steals, while converting 29 FDU turnovers into 44 points. Fairleigh Dickinson fell to 1-6 on the season.

WVU has won 11 consecutive games at the Coliseum dating back to last season and 22 consecutive games against non-conference foes at the Coliseum since 2013-14.

Freshman Katrina Pardee netted a season-high and team-leading 19 points. The Cedar Park, Texas, native made 7-of-14 from the field, including 3-of-7 behind the arc. Sophomore Teana Muldrov belted off 17 points and grabbed four rebounds. Tynice Martin and Bria Holmes rounded out WVU's double-figure scorers with 12 and 11 points, respectively. For a second consecutive game, Lanay Montgomery reached double-digit rebounding with a game-best 14 boards.

Offensively, West Virginia netted 54 percent (34-of-63) overall from the field and 4-of-14 (28.6 percent) from three-point range. The Mountaineers won the rebound battle 47-33 and dished out 23 assists. Holmes led the team with five assists, while Jessica Morton and Olivia Seggie contributed with four each. Morton also netted a career-high four steals.

Fairleigh Dickinson was limited to 25.0 percent (13-of-52) shooting. The Knights were held to 14 first half points before recording 11 in the third and 17 in the final period. Madelyn Comly led FDU with a team-best 12 points and three steals.

A hot offensive start catapulted the Mountaineers in the opening period. WVU started the game shooting 86 percent in the first five minutes, opening to a 13-2 lead. West Virginia closed out the period on an 8-0 run to take a commanding 27-7 lead. The Mountaineers finished shooting a season-best 78.5 percent in the first quarter.

In the second quarter, Morton's jumper pushed the Mountaineers' advantage to 31 at the 4:54 mark. FDU was held scoreless for nearly five minutes until Comly drained a jumper to make it a 44-12 contest. West Virginia maintained a 46-14 halftime lead. WVU converted 15 FDU turnovers into 22 points. Martin knocked down 5-of-7 from the field to lead the team with 10 points. The Mountaineers shot 56.3 percent (18-of-32), while holding FDU to 19.2 percent (5-of-26).

Free throws from Pardee and Alexis Brewer pushed WVU's lead to 51 with 34 seconds left in the third quarter. Brewer finished the contest with nine points. Both teams scored 17 points in the final quarter.
